




### ADVENTURE MARATHON








#### **REVIVAL OF STEAM SAFARI TRAIN EXCURSION**








#### WORLD TRAVEL MART LONDON

As many as 60 classic cars, including Hummer, Ferrari, Ford Thunder Bird (1960), Austin Mini (1967) Rolls Royce Silver Wraith (1939), Ford Mustang (1964), Humber Hawk (1957), Mercedes (108s), Chevrolet Corvette (1967) Willy's Jeep (1957), Volks Wagens, Peugeot and others will be part of the rally. After leaving Peshawar, the participants of classic cars rally continue its journey towards the Quaid-e-Azam Mausoleum — the last destination in the porticity of Karachi.

## KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA CUISINE & CULTURE FESTIVAL

The event for the skilled entrepreneurs, will be organized to market their handicrafts and boost income of their families. Artisans from all the regions of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa will participate in the event. Stalls will be established to display handicrafts, calligraphy, embroidery, stone carving, wax painting, metal work, wood carving, sitar making, Chitrali Patti, Gandhara Art, Charsadda chappal, maizaray work, pottery work, blacksmith work and a lot of other items. Apart, the rich aroma of local traditional cuisines to be cooked on spot will also attract the visitors to the festival.



### CHAUMOUS/ CHITIRMUS FESTIVAL (Winter Festival)

The grand winter festival of Kalash titled "Chitirmas or Chaumous Festival", begin on December 7th and continue till 22nd December every year. There is euphoria among the people of Kalash valley in Chitral district in the Chaumous Festival. The Kalash people organised a number of events including bonfire competitions, Mandahek, Sharaberayak and Savilakehari to celebrate the festival with religious zeal and zest. Foreign tourists don't miss the chance to witness the unique culture, traditions and religious rites, enjoy the glimpses of various events during the 15-day gala in the scenic valley.









### DAWN LIFESTYLE EXPO (SHOWCASING KP)

To showcase and highlight tourism potential in the province, the Tourism Department participate in the annual Dawn Lifestyle Expo hosted at Islamabad. The pavilion depicting Khyber Pakhtunkhwa culture and tourism set up at the expo consisting of ten stalls usually display Swati Shawls, handicrafts from Kalash, Peshawar, Charsadda Khadar, cultural items from Southern regions and jewelry made of copper and stone. The traditional and folk music is also part of the event to entertain visitors and tourists at the pavilion. The Tourism Department set up a special desk to disseminate information about tourism and cultural potential of the province through brochures, posters, booklets, video documentaries and pamphlets through which the families and visitors obtain details regarding scenic attractions and cultural diversity.















The Tourism Department is going to organise a Fish Festival on the banks of the Kabul River for the tourists and visitors. The organisers would arrange a competition of making different fish cuisines, including fish kabab, fish curry, fried fish, roasted fish, fish bar-b-que and others among the tourists. Besides boating in the Kabul River and horse-riding, traditional foods and music would also be part of the festival. Situated on the bank of River Kabul, the picnic spot is famous among people of the surrounding districts, including Peshawar, Nowshera, Mohmand, Mardan and Swabi. Sardaryab is among the best picnic spots across Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and famous for fresh fish eating. It is situated in the Charsadda district some 20-kilometre north on Peshawar-Charsadda road. The river is abundant with different kinds of fish including Mallhi, Singhara, Sher Mahi, Mahasher, Swati and Rahoo.

The participants equipped with snow hiking items, will exhibit their skills to cover 4 kilometer tough snow track from Dunga Gali to Mukshpuri Top. The participants will be facilitated by providing transportation, food, first aid kit, safety guidelines for snow hiking and other facilities during the event







The first-ever Hindu Kush Snow Sports Festival was held last year with colourful activities in the scenic Madaklasht Valley in Chitral district. The Second Hindu Kush Snow Sports Festival will be held this year in Madaklasht, showcasing a number of snow games including skiing, snow-tubing, trekking, snow-boarding, ice skating, ice hockey, making snow statues, snow curling and others. Traditional foods, local music and workshops on the topics of climate change and eco-tourism are also part of the winter gala.

### ORANGE + WATER SPORTS FESTIVAL



Khanpur has become a popular destination of water sports as well as of the citrus lovers when orange orchards reach their peak. Especially the red blood oranges are famous around the world for the distinct taste of their produce, besides other varieties, including hamlin, ruby red and shakry, oranges, mussammy, fruiters and grapefruit. To highlight the unique and different varieties of orange in the Khanpur, Orange Festival will be held at the fascinating Khanpur. Clubbed with the water sports activities, stalls comprising different local species of oranges, local handicrafts, food items and cultural artifacts would be put on display. While cultural shows like folk music and dance, horse dance, gatka game would be presented.



# MALAM-JABBA SKIING FESTIVAL

Located in the Hindu Kush Range of the serene Swat Valley the Malam Jabba host Malam Jabba Snow Festival annually. It offers the visitors different types of skiing, snowboarding, curling, skating, ice hockey along with a mesmerizing views of snow cladded peaks. The famous 800 m long ski slope is located in the Malam Jabba Skiing Resort with an elevation of 2804m (9199 ft.), which is the oldest ski resort of Pakistan. A number of national as well as international skiers and tourists throng to experience this thrilling activity in the snow season.



The 2nd International Snowboarding Competition will be organized at the scenic Malam Jabba. National and international male and female players will participate in the snowboarding, joint slalom and parallel joint slalom competitions. The foreign and local tourists throng the serene resort, to enjoy the Pakistan's largest zip line, chairlift, winter games and local music on the white snow in Malam Jabba.

### **HELI SKI**

Heli Ski was carried out for the first time in the unexplored snow cladded peaks of Kaghan Valley last year. This year the activity will be arranged for the national and international skiers. The activity is one of the most adrenaline-fuelled and adventurous activities in the mountains, which involves the thrill of accessing untapped terrain in the wilderness through helicopters.









Jashn-e-Qaqlasht or Qaqlasht Festival is the oldest festival of Upper Chitral, which holds in the green plateaus of Qaqlasht covered with snow-cladded Mountains nearby Boni. Qaqlasht festival is celebrated in the mid of April. Major festivities of the festival includes traditional sports like horse polo, donkey polo, tug of war, falcon prey, race, shooting (of 'Siyah Kaman'), local hockey, cricket, football and other activities like paragliding, uphill biking, , skate shooting, rock climbing, zip-lining, archery, Buddy Dik, Cultural show, Quiz competition, Mushaira, traditional food stalls and other local games/ activities. It also features music of reed instrument and that of pure Chitrali sitar. Folk dance includes 'chong righishi' and 'tatali wawali', and 'mamashish' which are at the verge of extinction







Chilim Jusht also known as Joshi Festival is the annual spring festival of Kalash Valleys. It is usually celebrating with great zeal and passion every year in the three valleys of Kalash namely Bumburate, Birir and Rumbur. Starting from 12th – 16th May, a tented village establishes during the festival for the tourists' facilitation. The festival starts with 'Milk day' on which Kalasha people offers milk that had been saved for 10 days prior to the occasion. The festival is the most important event of the Kalasha people as it signifies the end of chilling cold in the mountainous region and the people celebrate the arrival of spring and summer seasons.







#### NARAN FESTIVAL

The two-day Naran Festival is jointly organized by the district administration and the Tourism Department at Naran valley. The expected attendees including local and foreign tourists, youth, women and children will enjoy the event to be arranged at the bank of River Kunhar. Stalls of different items including, handicrafts, local culture, traditional and fast foods, folk music, tourist information centre, wildlife, play-land and swings for children and other entertaining segments will be the festivities of the event.

## HAZARA MUSIC FESTIVAL




















# MOUNTAIN BIKE RALLY
