UCHAU FESTIVAL, KALASH (Summer Festival)



The Kalasha people celebrate Uchau Festival as harvesting and bringing the cheese down from the higher pastures by the shepherds. The Kalasha people celebrate the festival in the month of July as "Rat Nat" night dance, as rituals and practice for the final day of Uchau. The cheese which are brought down from the pastures will be taken to the Alters and offer as thanksgiving for good livestock and harvest of crops and fruits. This festival is celebrated on from 20th - 22nd August each year. It takes place at day time in Rumbor valleys and night time at Bumburet valley which lasts until morning. Numbers of local as well as international tourists were moved towards the Kalash valleys to witness this spectacular event which is celebrated by the Kalash people from centuries.





GABEEN JABBA FESTIVAL

- Closing Ceremony in Mingora Swat






HUNER MELA 18-20 Sep 2022

Khandaganay (Revival of Amateur Comedy Family Theatre)




Saqafati Rang e Pakhtunkhwa (Promotion of Cultural Diversity) Nov 2022
